

Stockmate Bluetooth Installation

If you already have a version of Stockmate installed on your device, you will need to uninstall this before proceeding. Go to section 1.

Otherwise, proceed to section 2.

1 Uninstall StockMate

1.1 This will remove all StockMate data from your device. Ensure you have retrieved all count data from your tablet before proceeding.

1.2 On most devices, holding the StockMate Liquor icon will cause an Uninstall option to appear near the top of the screen. If this is the case with your device, you can drag the icon over the Uninstall icon and confirm the uninstall. Repeat this for StockMate Food if you have the app installed.

1.3 If your device doesn't support this, you will need to open **Settings**, select **Apps** in the Device section, scroll down the list and tap the StockMate Liquor line. There will be an Uninstall option for you to tap. Repeat this for StockMate Food if you have the app installed.

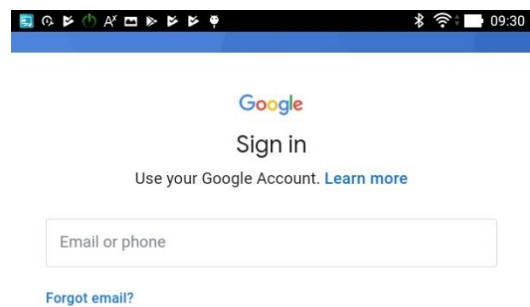
2 Sign into Play Store

2.1 Open Play Store on your device. It's icon is normally on the device home screen and looks like this :



2.2 You should have a Google account already associated with your device from your initial set-up. If not, you will be prompted by Play Store to sign in

2.2 If you have a Google account, enter your details and tap **Next**



2.3 At the bottom right of the sign-in screen, there is the "Create account" option

Select this and follow the on-screen steps if you don't have a Google account

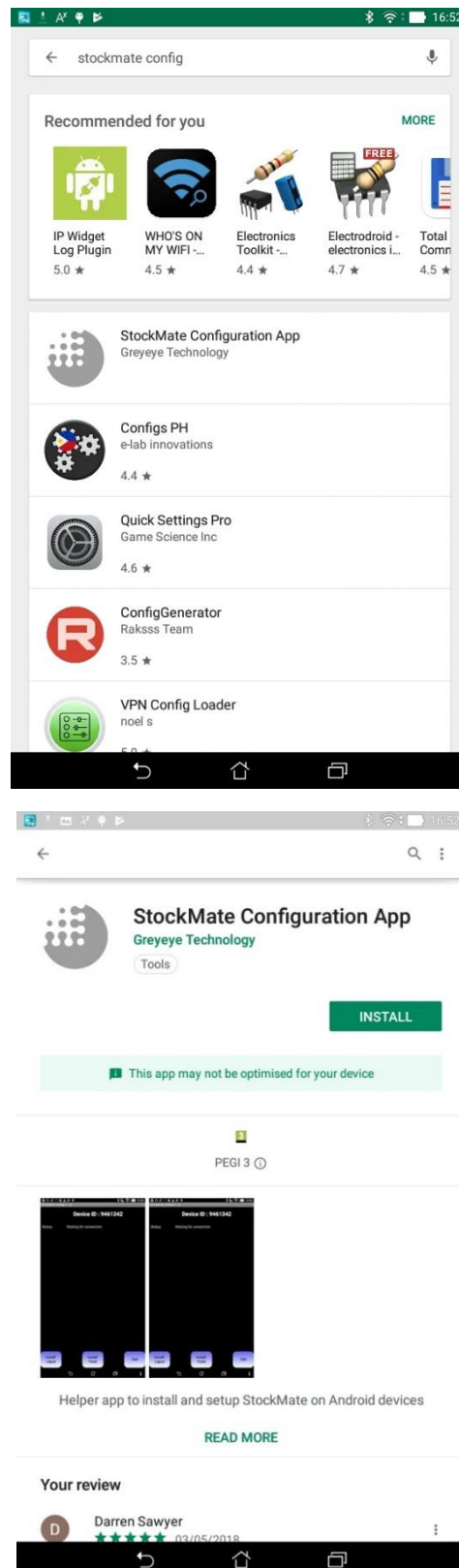


3 Install StockMate Config App

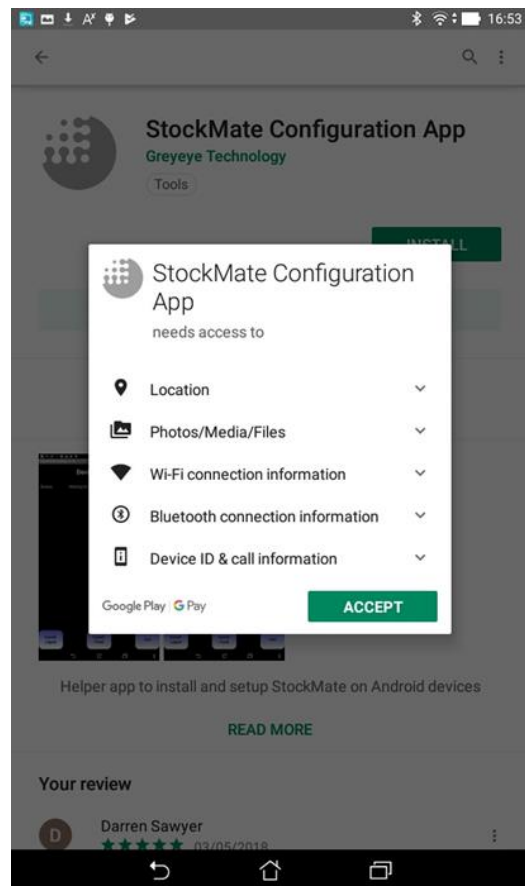
3.1 Type **stockmate config** into the search box in Play Store

3.2 Tap on the **StockMate Configuration App** icon

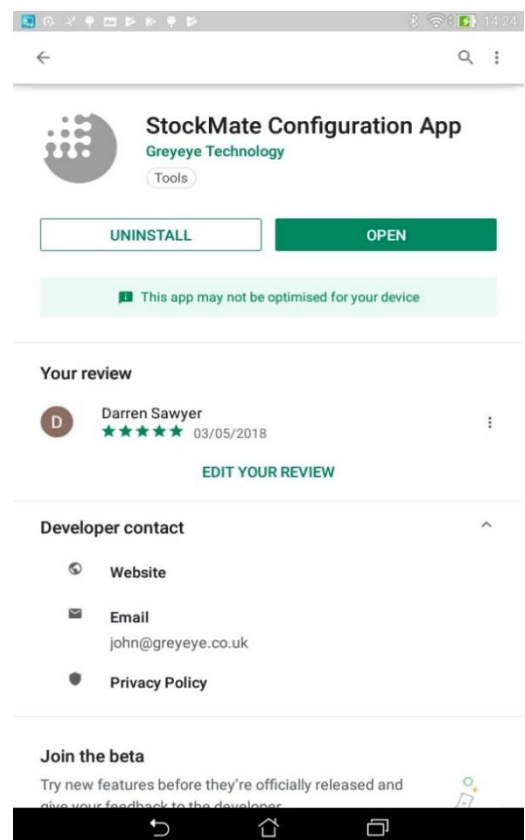
3.3 Tap on the **Install** button



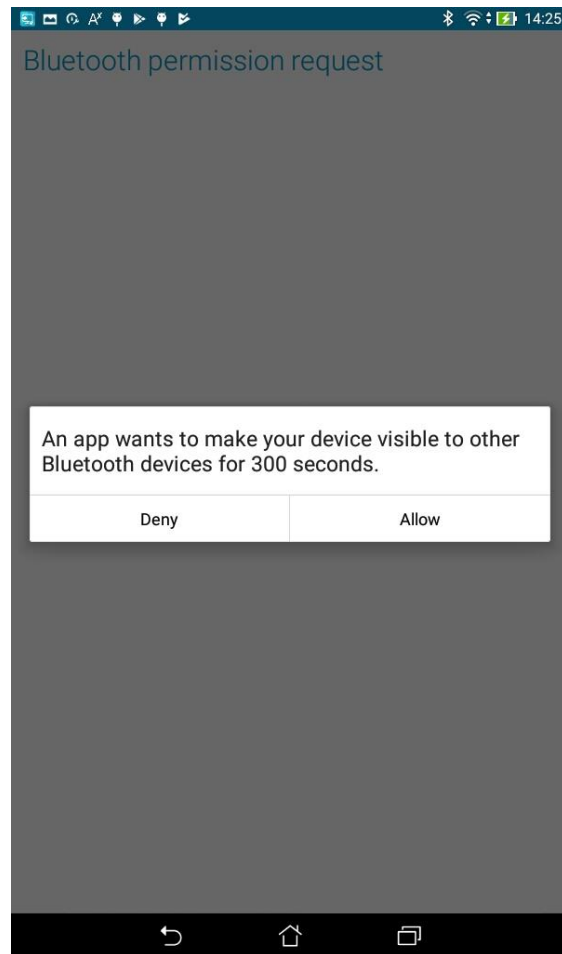
3.4 Tap **Accept** to allow the necessary app permissions



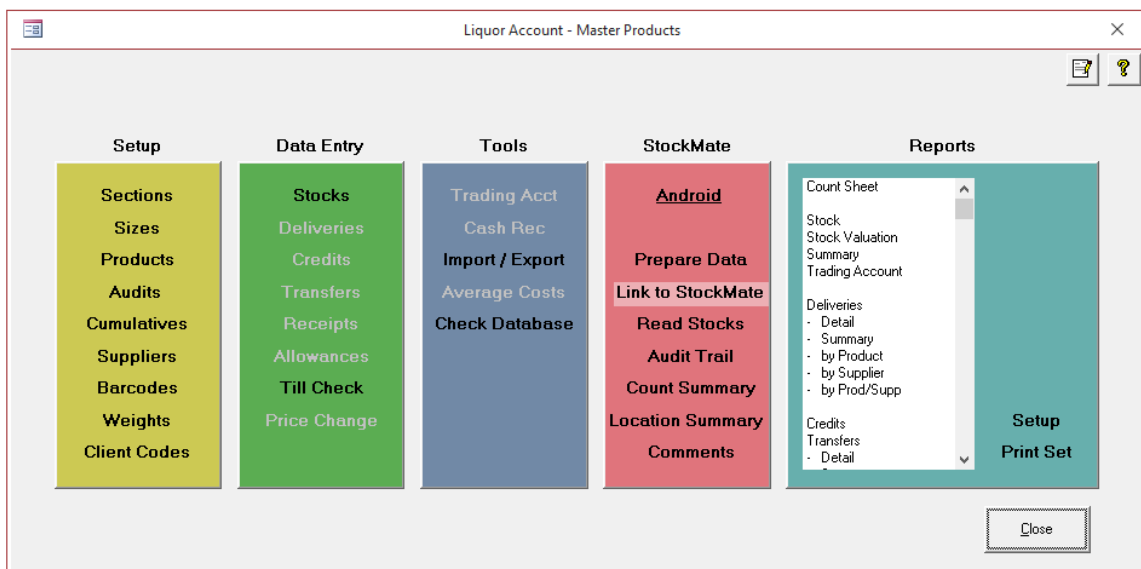
3.5 Tap **OPEN**



3.6 Tap **Allow** to activate Bluetooth device discovery



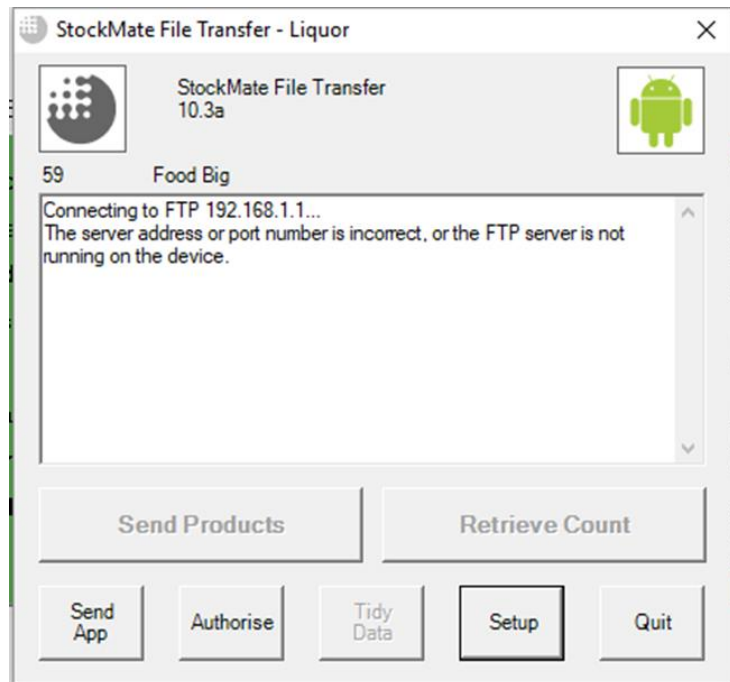
3.7 On the PC, in StockManager click **Link to StockMate**



3.8 The File transfer window will open

If you have previously used StockMate via WiFi a connection attempt will be made

Wait for this to complete or fail



3.9 Click **Setup**

Address, Port, Username and Password or not used for Bluetooth connection and can be ignored


3.10 Tick the **Use Bluetooth** checkbox


3.11 Select your device from the dropdown list

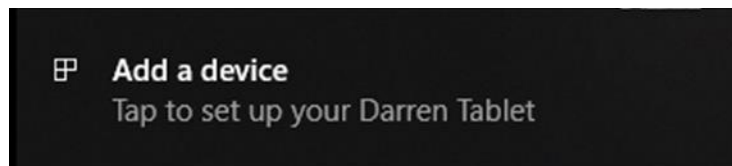
3.12 Bluetooth pairing will initiate



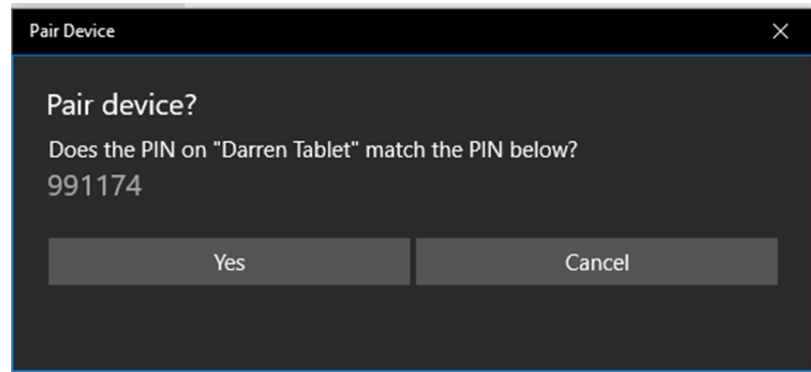

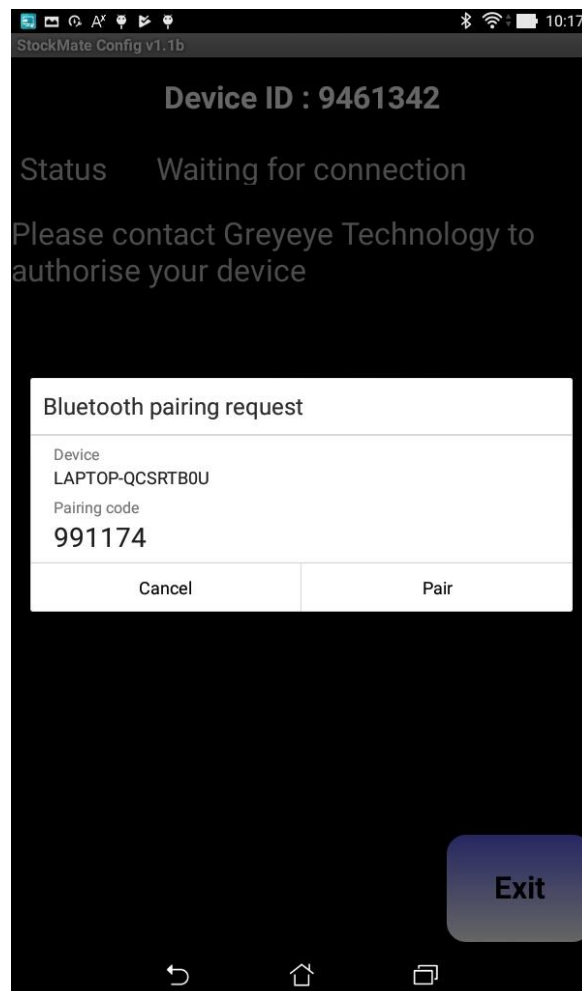
3.13 On a Windows 10 computer, a device notification will appear



3.14 You will be asked to confirm the pairing request



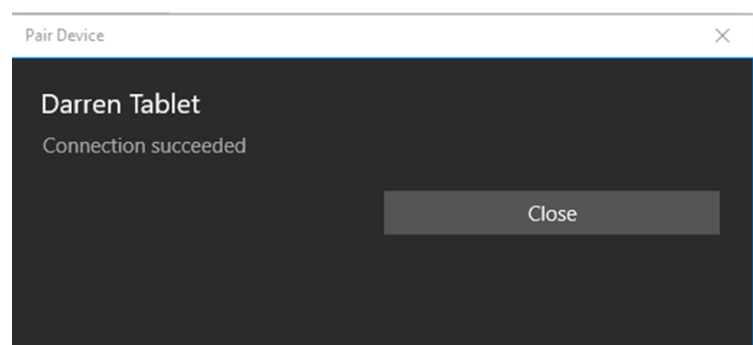
3.15 The pairing request will also be displayed on the android device



3.16 Check the codes match, then tap **Pair** on the device, and **Yes** on the computer

3.17 You should see this message on the computer

Click **Close**

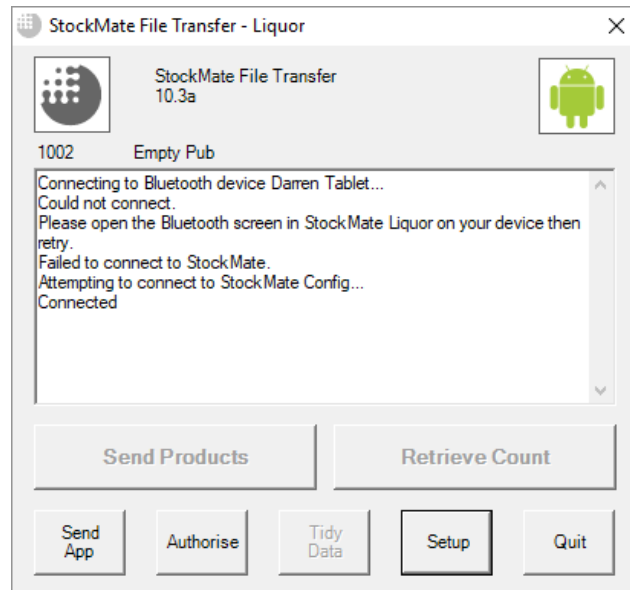


3.18 The file transfer window will indicate a connection to StockMate Config

If for any reason this connection fails, click on the green Android robot logo to retry

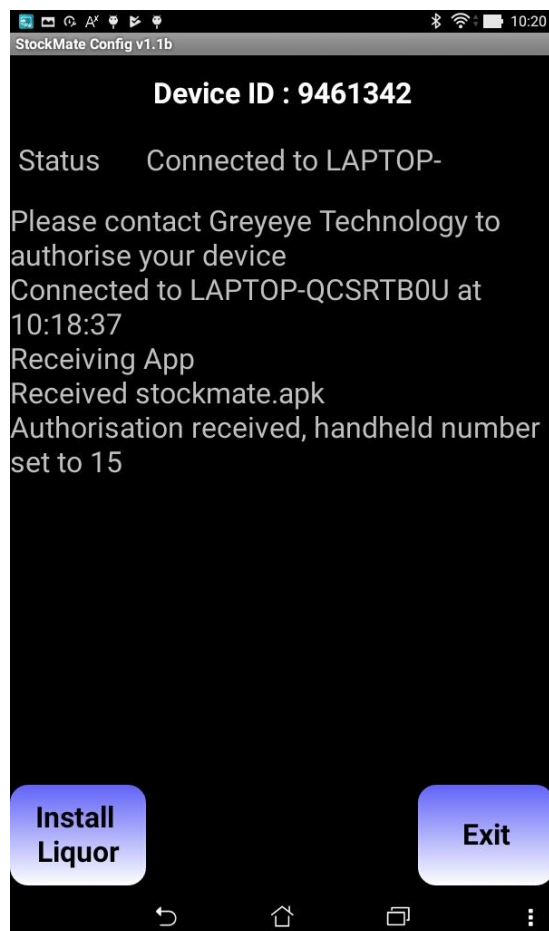
3.19 Click **Send App** and wait for the transfer to complete

3.20 Click **Authorise** and wait for the transfer to complete



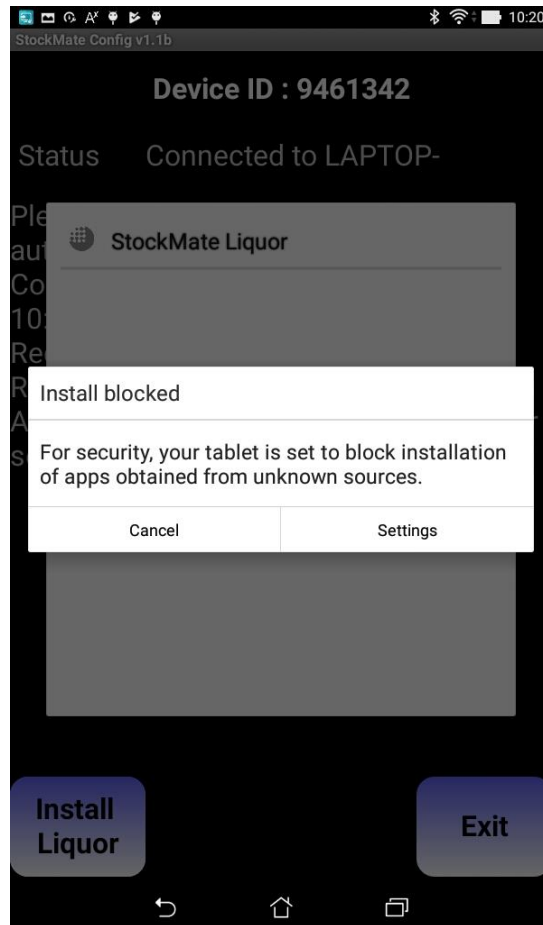
3.21 **Install Liquor** option will appear on the android device

3.22 Tap **Install Liquor**



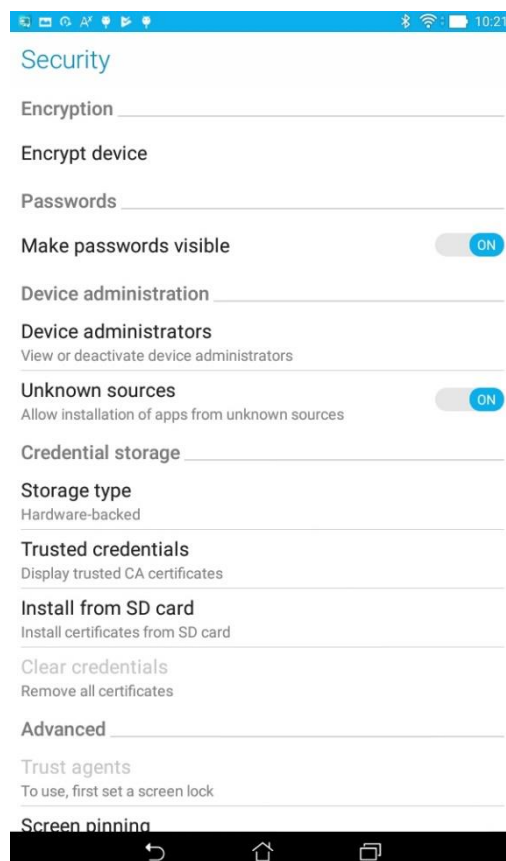
3.23 Your security settings may restrict the install. If so, you will see a similar message to this

3.24 Tap **Settings**

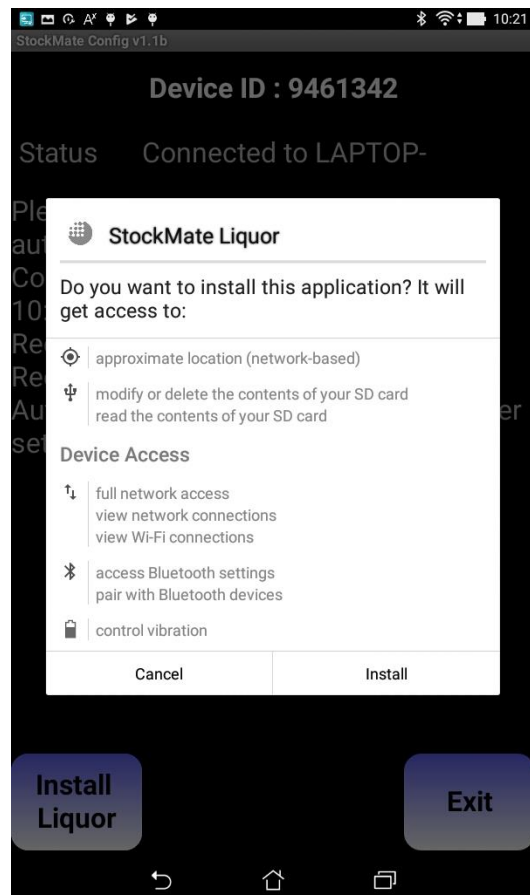


3.25 Tap the switch next to **Unknown sources**

3.26 On some devices, the install will continue automatically. On others, you will need to tap the back button and tap **Install Liquor** again



3.27 Tap Install



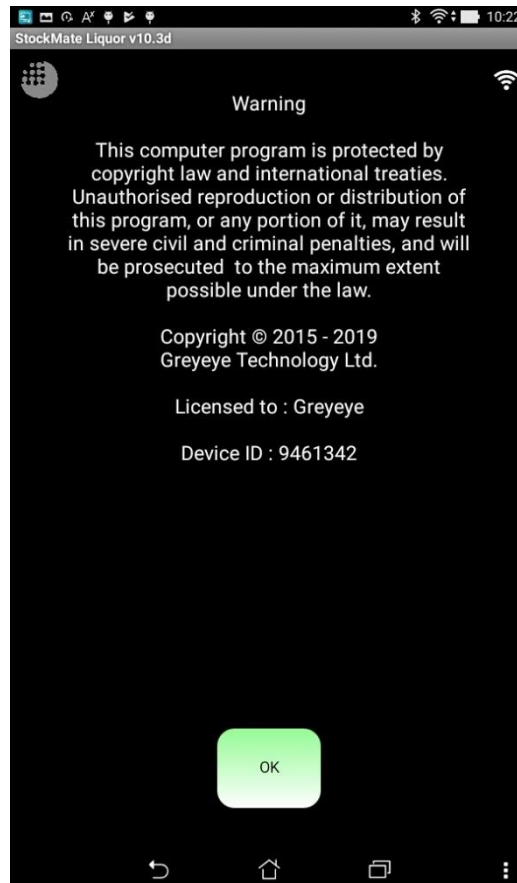
3.28 When the app is installed, tap Open



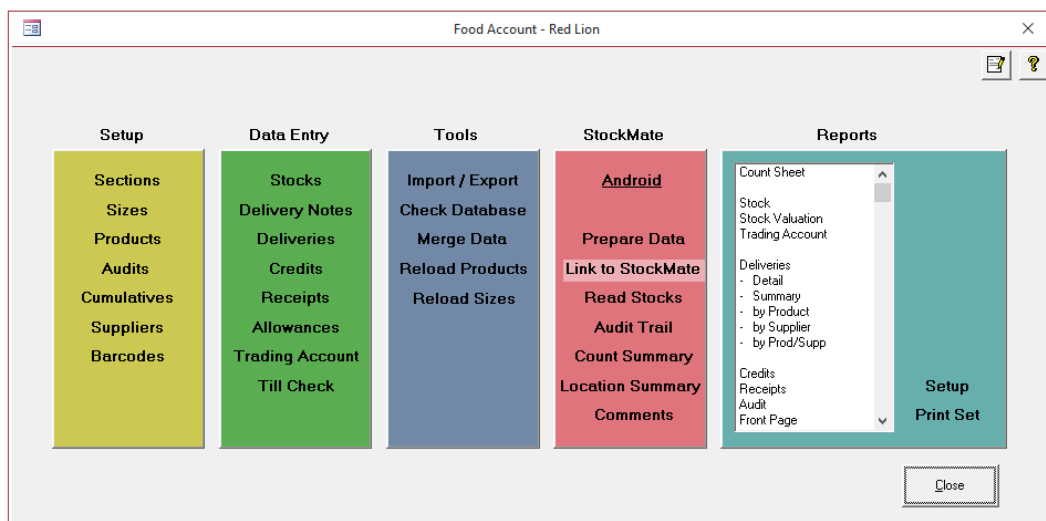
3.29 StockMate Liquor should open and display the copyright warning screen

3.30 If you don't see this message, contact Greyeye Technology

3.31 Tap the back button to exit the app

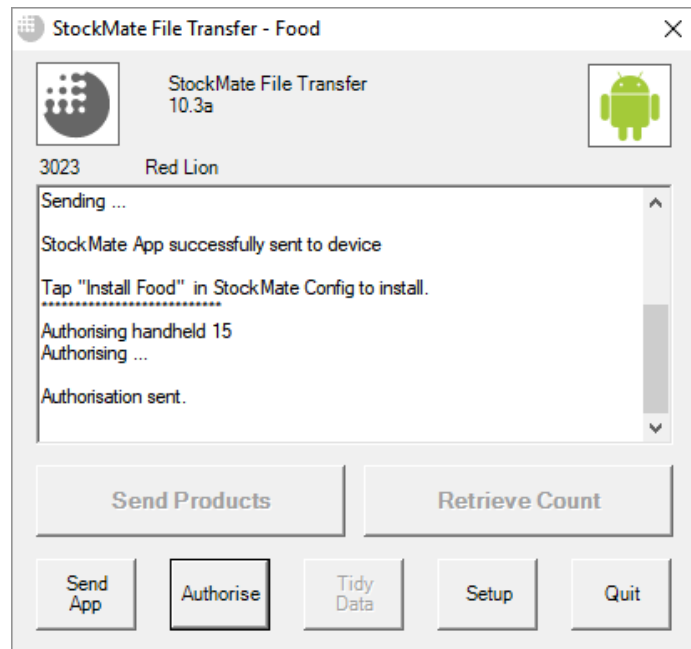


3.32 If you will be using StockMate Food, you will also need to install the app. Select a food outlet in StockManager, go into the Food section and click **Link to StockMate**

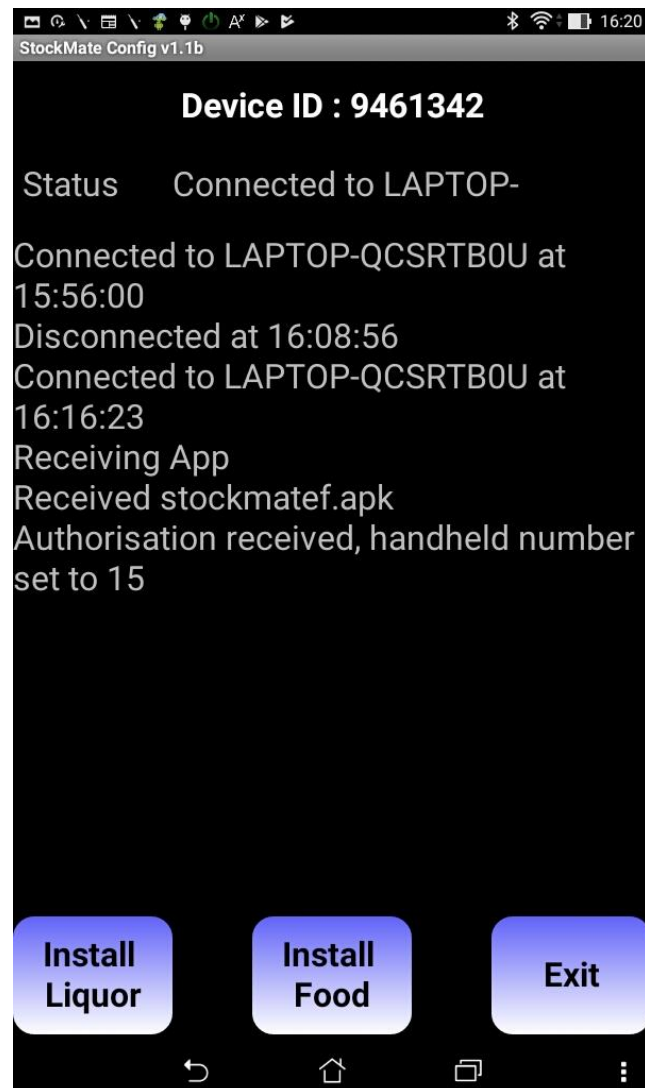


3.33 Click **Send App** and wait for the confirmation message

3.34 Click **Authorise** and wait for the confirmation message

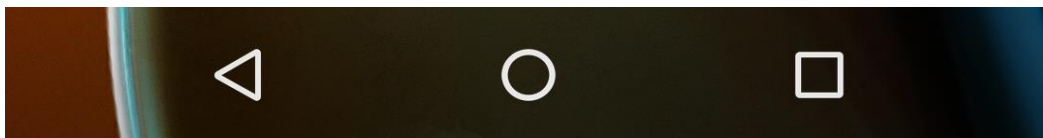


3.35 Tap the **Install Food** option on the android device and continue with the installation as for the liquor app



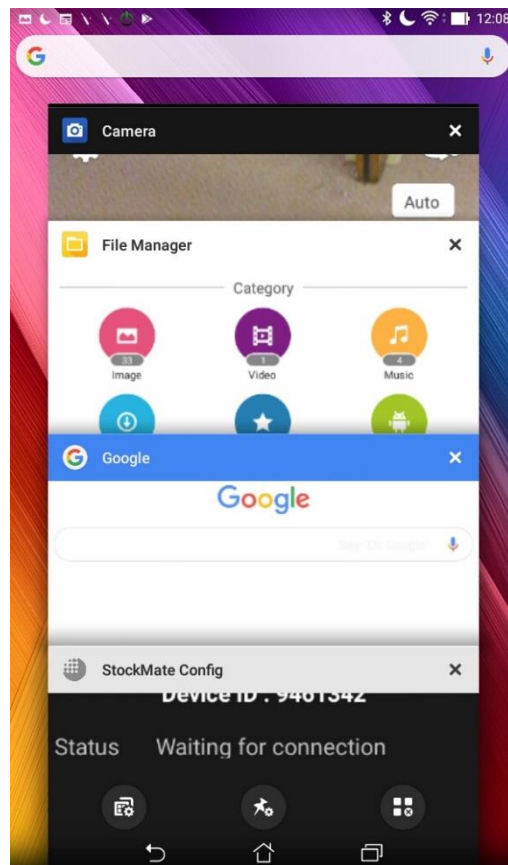
4 Sending and retrieving data

4.1 If you've just installed the StockMate apps, ensure that StockMate Config is not running. You can do this by tapping the android **Overview** button. This is the **right side button** of the three android system buttons which are displayed at the bottom of the screen. Their appearance varies by device and android version, here are two common ones:

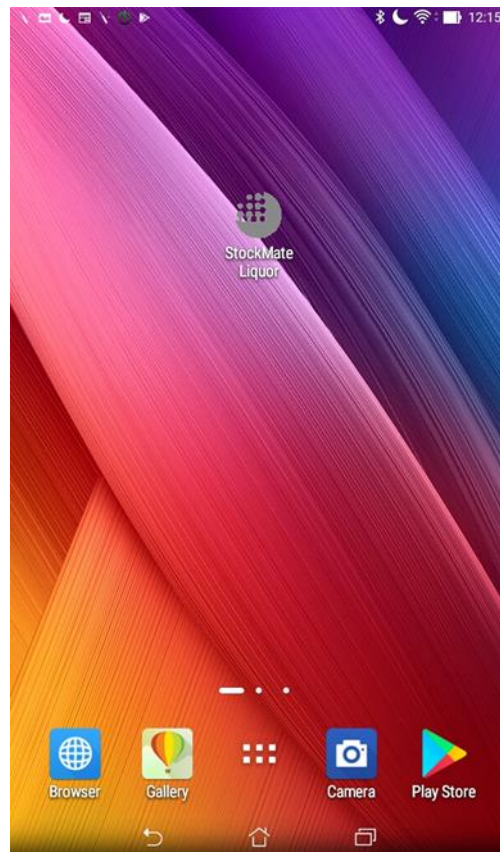



This displays a set of windows for apps you have recently run. Swipe up or down to scroll through the list.

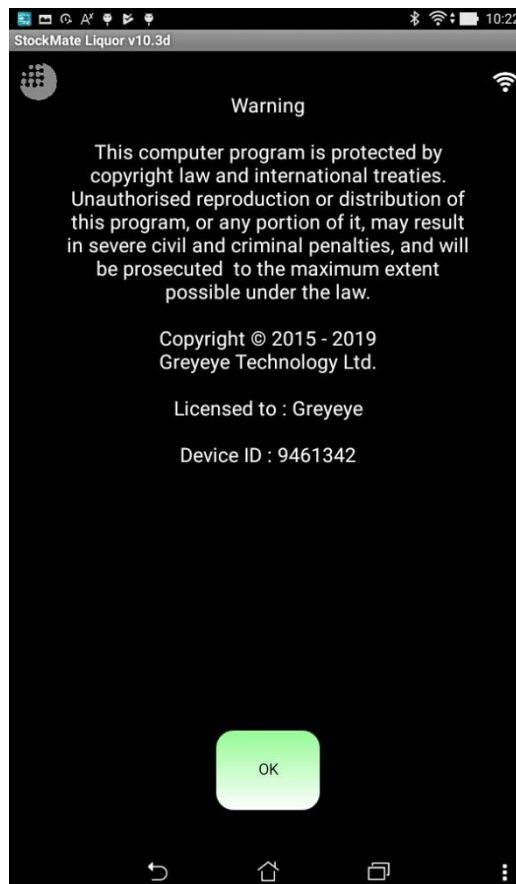
4.2 Tap the **X** at the top right corner of the StockMate Config window to close the app



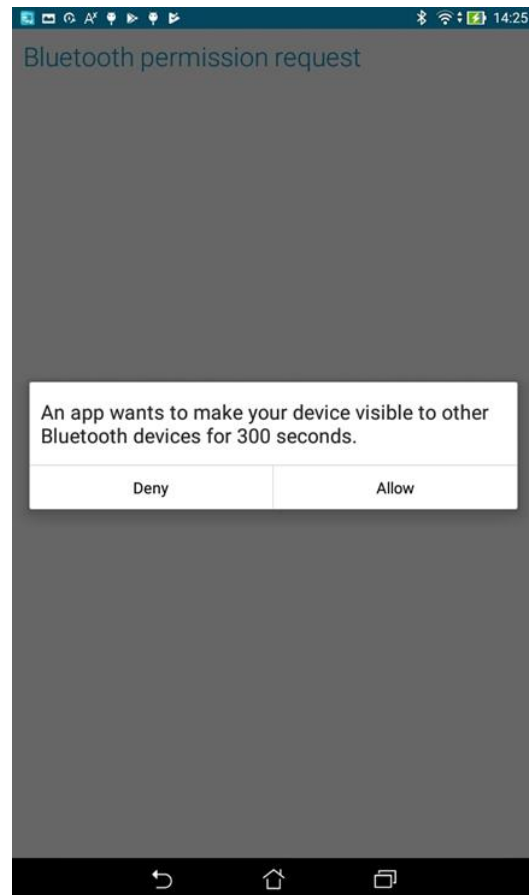
4.3 Tap the **StockMate Liquor** icon to open the app



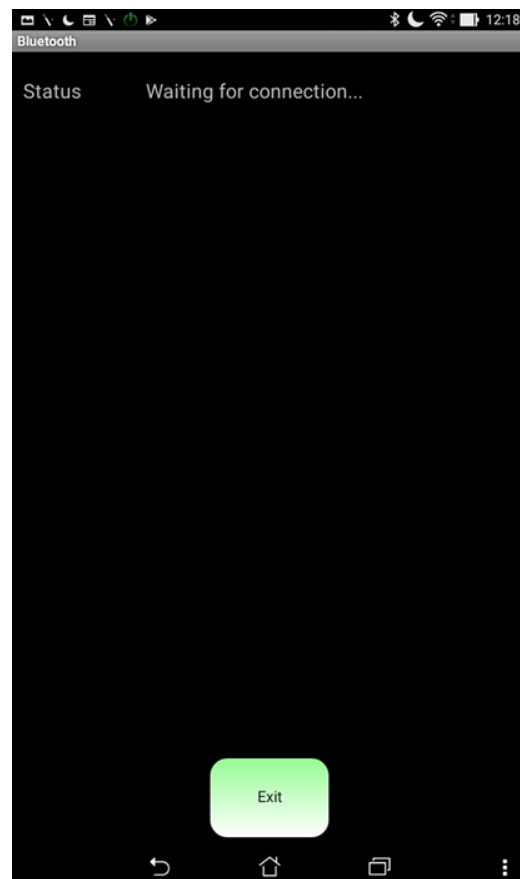
4.4 Tap the communications icon  in the top right corner



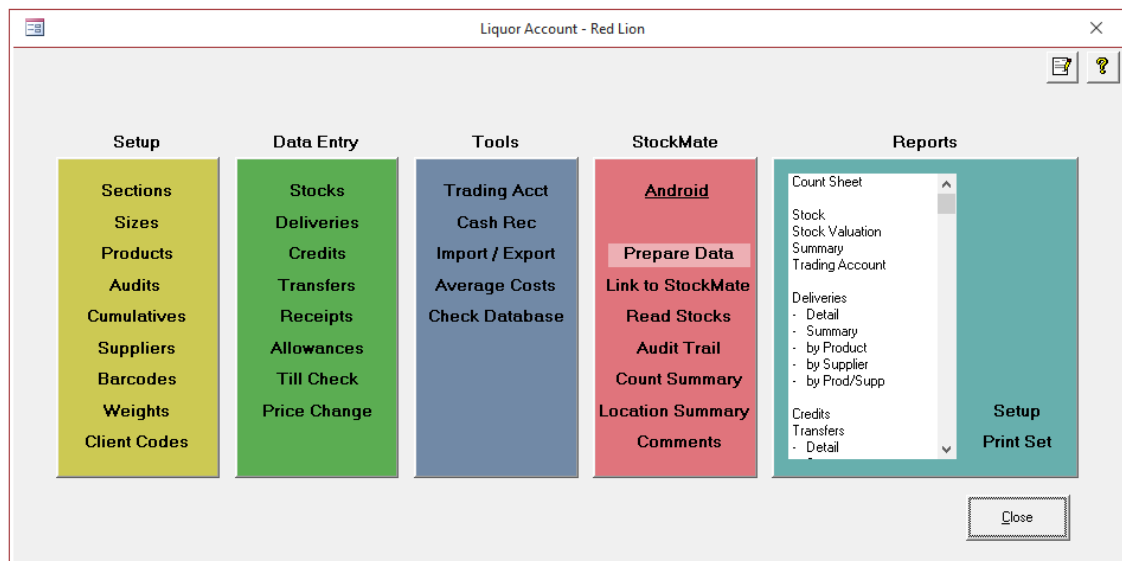
4.5 Your device should already be paired with your computer, so you can tap **Deny** for the Bluetooth permission request



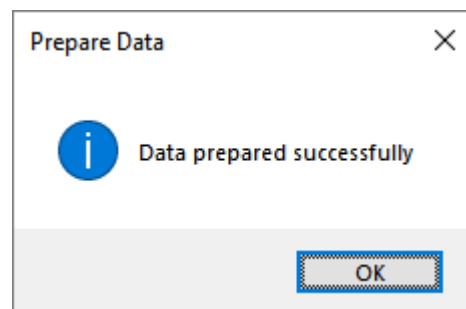
4.6 Your communications screen will look like this



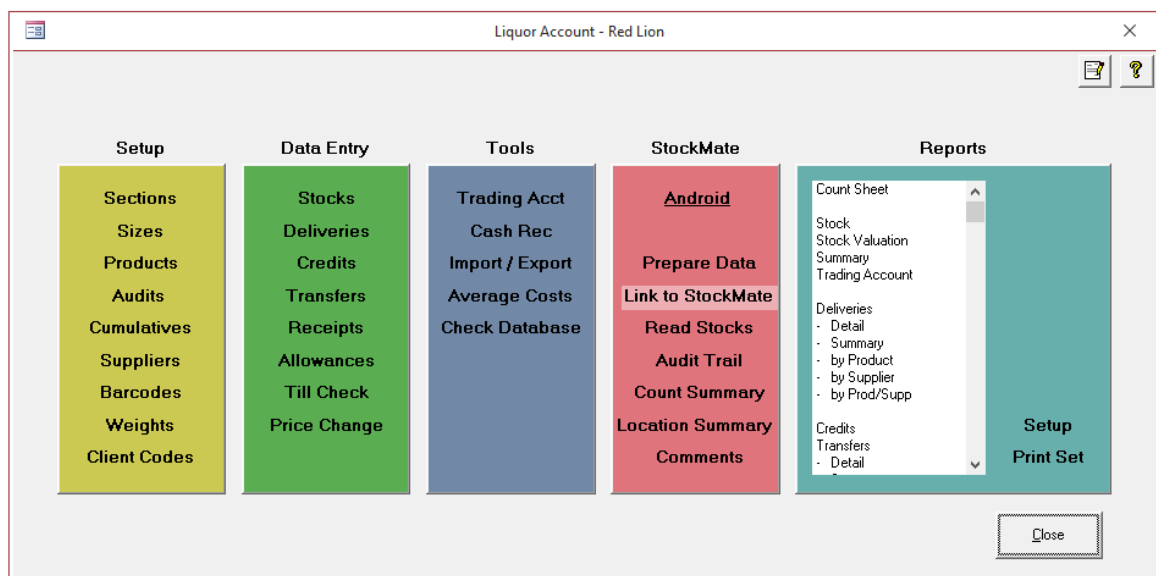
4.7 In StockManager on the computer, click on **Prepare Data**



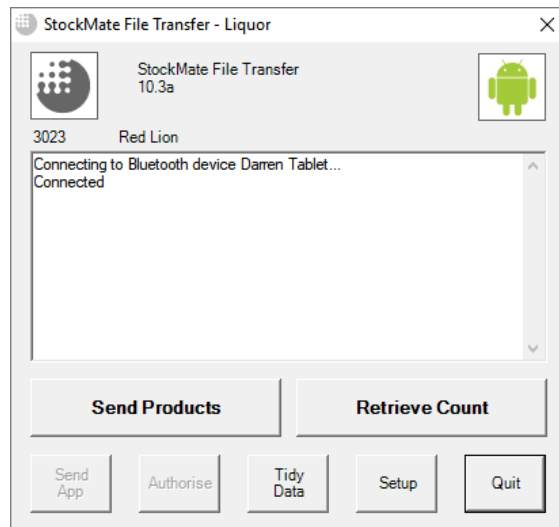
4.8 Click **OK** to the success message



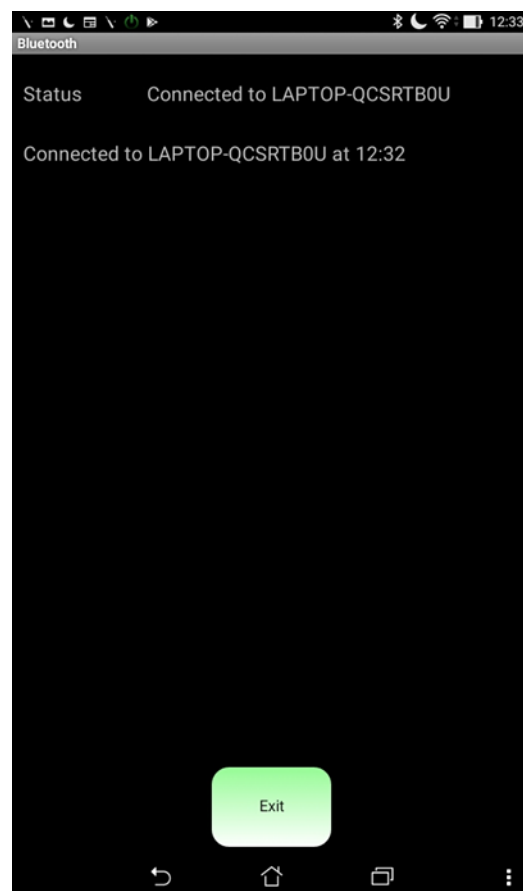
4.9 Click **Link to StockMate**



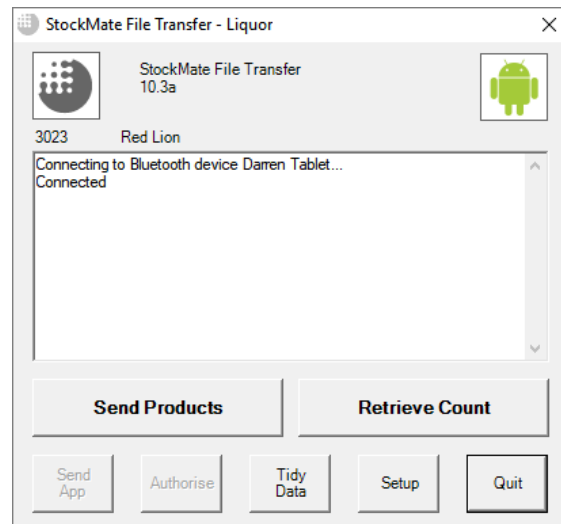
4.10 In the File Transfer window, you should receive the connected message



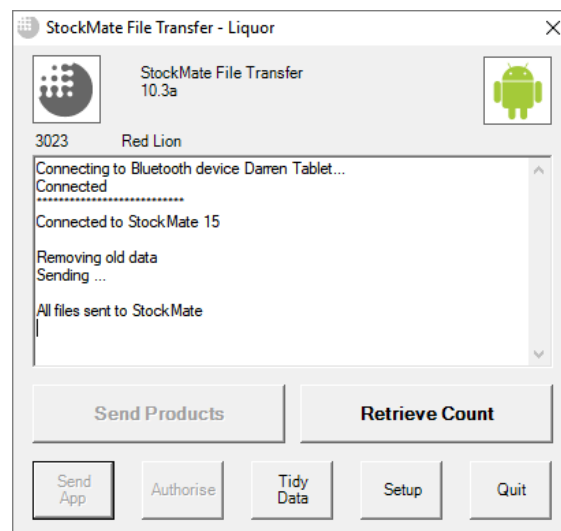
4.11 On the android device, you should see the connected message



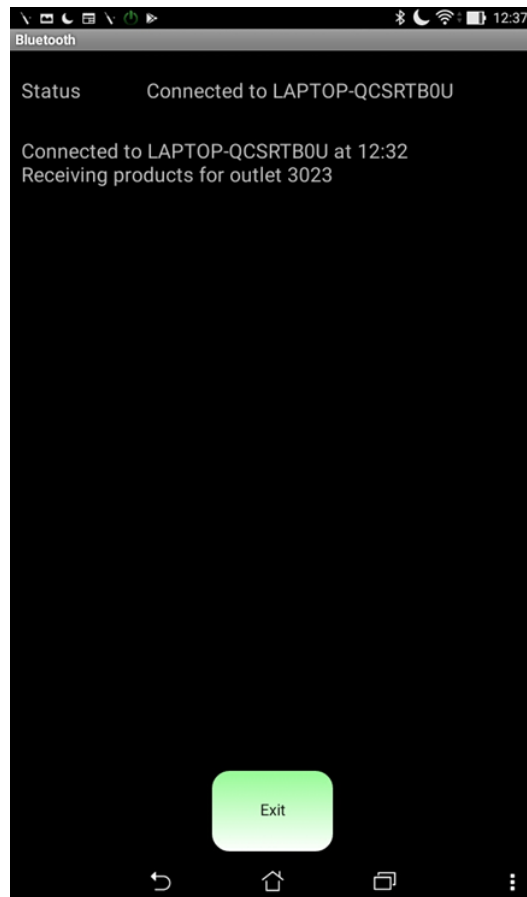
4.12 Click **Send Products** on the computer



4.13 The status window gives the message **All files sent to StockMate** to indicate success.



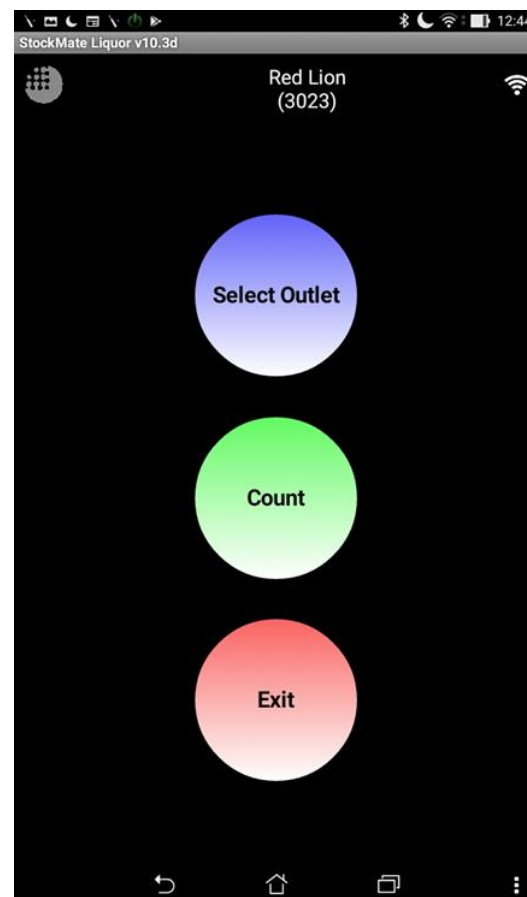
4.14 On the android device, you will also see confirmation



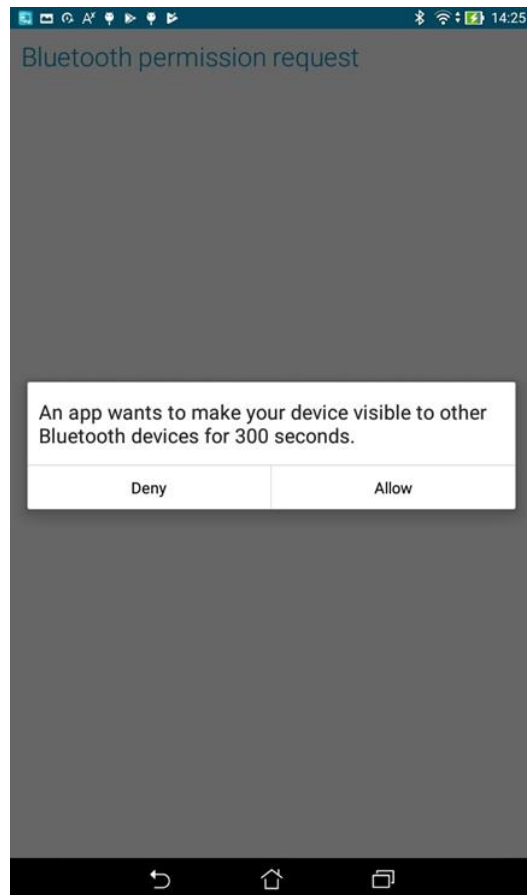
4.15 Tap **Exit** to exit the comms screen

You can now complete a count on your device as normal.

4.16 When you have finished counting, tap the comms icon in the top right to open the comms screen again



4.17 You can **Deny** the Bluetooth permission request



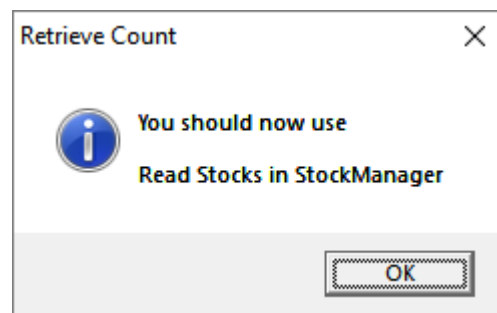
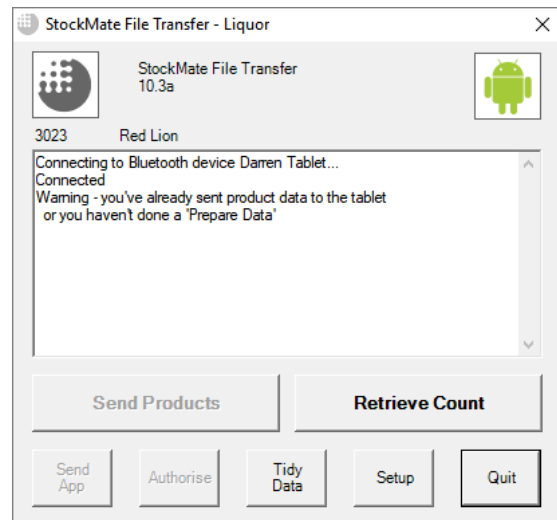
4.18 StockMate will indicate it is waiting for a connection



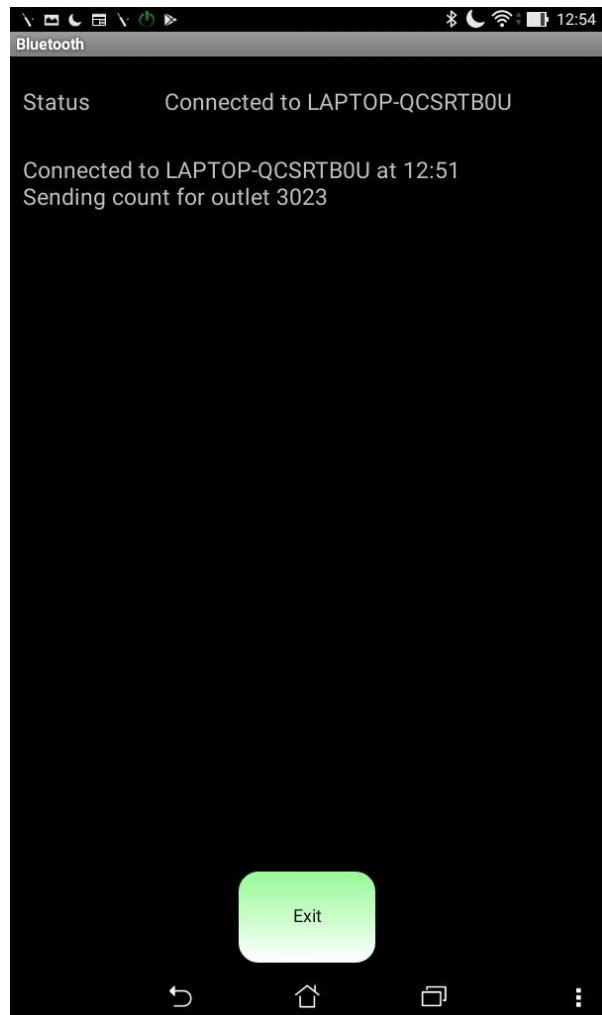
4.19 Click on **Link to StockMate** in Stockmanager

4.20 Click **Retrieve Count**

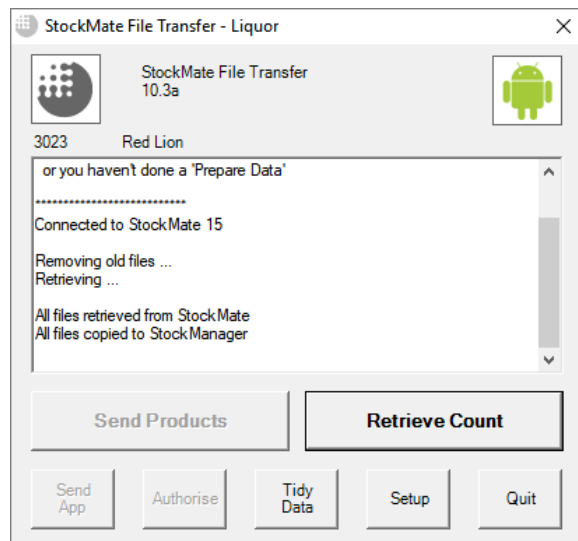
4.21 You will see the reminder to use **Read Stocks**



4.22 The StockMate comms screen will confirm it has sent the count



Tap **Exit** to disconnect from Bluetooth



4.23 Click **Quit** in the File transfer window
